

# CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Each coach must control their own players, spectators and themselves. A coach or player receiving two technical fouls will be ejected from the next game, gym and grounds. Further more they will be suspended from the next game, gym and grounds also. A third technical foul called on the same bench will result in an automatic forfeit of the game by that team.

Physical Abuse, Abusive language and or harassment by a spectator will result in their automatic ejection from the gym and grounds. The C.B.Y.B.A. has a ZERO tolerance for physical contact with the referees, official book and timers and encourages prosecution of such offenses.

The referee will inform the coach or coaches, as well as the gym supervisor who will facilitate the removal of the offender(s). Play will not resume until this person(s) has left the gym and grounds. Any refusal to leave will result in the offending teams forfeiture of the game.

Information regarding the ejection of a player, coach or spectator must be forwarded to the C.B.Y.B.A. Board with that weeks scores so that proper action may be taken.

The C.B.Y.B.A. Board has the authority to approve, appoint, dismiss or rule ineligible any player, coach or spectator who violates the Rules and or Mission Statement of this organization. This can include the suspension of a player as the result of a related coach or spectators actions.

A Conduct Agreement must be signed and on file with C.B.Y.B.A. for each coach, player and parent in order to be included on the official roster.
